**Discussion:** The Academic Council meticulously examined the examination results and was satisfied with the process followed. Dr. R. Rajeswara Rao, University Nominee, JNTUK, observed that the pass percentages, especially in core branches, were relatively low. He suggested that departments should initiate preparatory classes and take additional academic support measures such as remedial sessions and monitoring of academically weaker students to improve overall student performance and enhance pass percentages in future examinations.

**Resolution:** The Academic Council resolved to ratify the results of the examinations conducted during Nov & Dec 2025 as listed below. It was also resolved that departments shall initiate special academic support measures to improve student performance, particularly in the core engineering branches.

During the discussion, Dr. G. Padmaja Rani, Director of Evaluation, JNTUK and University Nominee, informed that the classification of "First Class with Distinction" shall be awarded only to those students who do not have any supplementary appearance, as per the JNTUK guidelines.

In this context, the Chairperson brought to the notice of the Council that, inadvertently, First Class with Distinction was awarded to certain MCA students who had supplementary

appearances and the same was approved in the 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Academic Council Meetings, and Provisional Certificates (PCs) were issued accordingly. Further, 02 out of 07 MCA Provisional Certificates in the present (13<sup>th</sup>) Academic Council were kept pending for approval due to their supplementary appearance.

The Chairperson informed that a detailed verification has been carried out, and it is proposed to revise the classification for such MCA students and reissue the Provisional Certificates, in accordance with JNTUK guidelines. It is further proposed that the revised list of MCA students (placed in 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup> Academic Council) will be placed before the next (14<sup>th</sup>) Academic Council Meeting for its approval after necessary corrections, as per the JNTUK guidelines. *cancelled PCs also will be presented before the academic council,*

However, the Provisional Certificates pertaining to B.Tech and MBA students, who are found eligible as per JNTUK norms, are proposed for approval in the present meeting. **Proposal:** It is proposed to implement the revised Examination Procedures and Results Processing Procedures issued by JNTUK vide **Proc. No. E/JNTUK/Examination Procedures/UEC/2025 dated 26-11-2025** and **Proc. No. E/JNTUK/Results Processing/UEC/2025 dated 24-11-2025** for UG and PG programmes.

**Discussion:** The Chairperson presented the revised examination and results processing procedures issued by JNTUK and explained the following key changes compared to the existing practices followed by the institution.

**(a) Revaluation Procedure:**

If the difference between the first valuation (v1) and second valuation (v2) is  $\leq 20\%$  of the maximum marks, the average of v1 and v2 will be considered as final marks.

If the difference is  $> 20\%$  of the maximum marks, the answer script will be sent for third valuation (v3) and the average of v1, v2 and v3 will be taken as final marks.

**(b) Moderation of Results:** Moderation of results will be applied if the pass percentage of a course is low due to question paper difficulty. If the pass percentage in any course is less than "X", then maximum of "Y" marks as given below shall be added to all students attempted that course provided the student gets at least 1 mark. The obtained marks should not exceed the maximum marks after the moderation of the results.

| Limits of percentage (X) | Marks (Y) |
|--------------------------|-----------|
| <30%                     | 5 marks   |
| 30% to <40%              | 4 Marks   |
| 40% to <50%              | 3 Marks   |

**(c) Grace marks:** A total of 5 marks shall be considered as grace marks, which shall be added to the failed courses if the student passes in 1 or more courses by adding these marks. Grace marks are to be given after course moderation.

Grace marks are added only to the regular theory courses. In case student fail in more than one course, grace marks shall be given to those courses which require less grace marks.

No moderation and/or grace marks will be permitted to Lab/Project/Internships/Comprehensive viva-voce/ Supplementary theory courses.

Dr. G. Padmaja Rani, Director of Evaluation, JNTUK and University Nominee, suggested that the examination procedures and the results processing procedures, including revaluation,

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moderation marks and grace marks, should be followed in toto as per the procedures adopted by the JNTUK to maintain uniformity across all affiliated and autonomous institutions.

**Resolution:** The Academic Council approved the implementation of the revised Examination and Results Processing Procedures issued by JNTUK, including revaluation, moderation and grace marks, to be followed in toto as per JNTUK guidelines, with effect from II (Even) Semester of A.Y. 2025–26.

**Proposal:** It is proposed that failure in MOOC courses offered through platforms such as NPTEL/SWAYAM shall not be considered while awarding the classification of “First Class with Distinction” under MIC23 B.Tech Regulations.

**Discussion:** The Chairperson informed the members that some students are failing in MOOC courses offered through NPTEL/SWAYAM, which are conducted and evaluated by external agencies outside the institution. As per MIC23 Regulations, First Class with Distinction is awarded to students securing CGPA  $\geq 7.5$  without supplementary appearance; however, since MOOC courses are conducted by external agencies, failure in such courses should not affect the classification of the degree. Dr. G. Padmaja Rani, Director of Evaluation, JNTUK and University Nominee, confirmed that MOOC failure will not affect the award of First Class with Distinction.

**Resolution:** It is resolved that failure in MOOC courses offered through NPTEL/SWAYAM shall not be considered while awarding the classification of “First Class with Distinction” under MIC23 B.Tech Regulations.

The Academic Council was very positive in its approach throughout the meeting. All agenda items were discussed in detail and the deliberations were constructive and to the point. The meeting of the Academic Council concluded at 12:30 PM with the Chairperson thanking all the members for their participation.
