It was also informed that JNTUK has released the guidelines for Community Service Project and according to those guidelines, a student shall do the Community Service Project after completion of I B.Tech, II sem and evaluation process & credit allotment is not mentioned in the guidelines. The Director Academic Planning, JNTUK Dr. KVSG Murali Krishna informed that the university is in the process of preparing common guidelines for evaluation & credit allotment of Community Service Project as per APSCHE directions and has asked the Chairperson to write a letter to university for necessary guidelines. recommendation of the HOD and attempt it again.

If the same subject(s) is not offered in the subsequent semester, the end examination is to be conducted by the college for 100 marks.

Dr. B. Balakrishna, Director of Evaluation, suggested that the end examination for MOOCs shall not be conducted by the college and recommended that the student shall register for the same or alternative subject in the subsequent semester.

Resolution: After a wide range of discussions, the Academic Council approved the following evaluation methodology for the courses registered through MOOCs for both UG & PG.
