Proposal: The evaluation process of the community service project under MIC20 regulations was placed before the Academic Council for its approval.

Discussion: The Chairperson informed the Council that as per the directions from JNTUK, it is proposed to award 4 credits to the Community Service Project (CSP) by reducing the same credits in the final year project so that the total credits are limited to 160.

The following evaluation methodology is proposed for CSP:

- Students are permitted to do the community service project during the semester break of 2nd year (15 days) and 3rd year (15 days).
- 2. The community service project will be evaluated in III year II sem for 4 credits.
- A group of students will be assigned to a faculty mentor, who will be in-charge of the students' learning activities and will continuously assess the students.
- A log book, has to be maintained by each of the student, in which the activities undertaken/involved are to be recorded.
- 5. The log book has to be countersigned by the mentor/faculty in-charge concerned.
- After completion of the project, each student should submit a report. An internal vivavoce examination shall be conducted by the department committee, which consists of a faculty mentor, head of the department and a senior faculty member in the department.

- 7. There will be only internal evaluation for CSP.
- 8. CSP will be evaluated for 100 marks
